Purpose

This statement confirms, in a single page, the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) and safeguarding leadership position of Pocket Money Adventures CIC as of 24 April 2026. It is provided to partner schools, sponsors, and any other party with a legitimate interest in PMA's safeguarding evidence.

DBS position

- Nathan Waldron, Director and Designated Safeguarding Lead, holds an Enhanced DBS check with children's barred list. The certificate number is available on request by a headteacher or DSL, and will be shown in person on arrival at any school session.
- Nathan's DBS is enrolled on the DBS Update Service and is subject to an online recheck before any new school engagement.
- Bernadette Houlton, Deputy DSL (appointed 22 April 2026), is going through the Enhanced DBS process via the same umbrella body. PMA's policy is that no person attends a school visit without a valid Enhanced DBS on record — until Bernadette's certificate is issued, she does not attend school sites in a delivery capacity.
- No other PMA person attends school sites without first completing the Safer Recruitment Register entry (Document 06, reference PMA-HR-SRR).

Nathan has read and operates to Keeping Children Safe in Education (KCSIE) 2025. Bernadette has read and operates to KCSIE 2025. The PMA Safeguarding Policy v1.3 and Safeguarding Handbook v1.1 reflect KCSIE 2025 requirements in full. PMA also observes Working Together to Safeguard Children 2023, the Prevent Duty, and IICSA recommendations.

Safeguarding routes by jurisdiction

PMA maintains live LADO and safeguarding referral routes for the partner local authorities it operates in. As of 24 April 2026 these are Stoke-on-Trent (Adrian Ward, Paul Harrow, Beverly Fisher), Staffordshire, Cheshire West and Chester, and Cheshire East. All routes are maintained in the Operational Reference Hub and reviewed monthly.
